Making a Difference

100% direct giving: 100% of your donations made this possible.

School Nutrition and Health Programs Grew 17 varieties of vegetables and 6 varieties of fruits at 4 school farms to boost 2,850 daily school meals for 950 students in Meru, Kenya.

Funded deworming health intervention program for 1,000 school children.

Purchased staple foods (rice, beans, flour, cooking oil) for 625,000+ school meals served to 570 children and youth.



Climate smart irrigation: Installed 1 solar borehole pump for access to clean water and irrigation for fruit and vegetables at a school farm.



Constructed 2 new school fishponds for a total of 10 fishponds stocked and maintained to provide a weekly fish meal as an additional protein source to 950 children.

Trained 257 school youth on best practices to grow their own food for improved self-sufficiency.



Expanded school livestock program with **rabbit** husbandry.

Maintained school livestock piggery and chicken programs.

Provided seeds, skills and tools to an additional **1,500+ women** from 2 counties in rural Kenya to grow vegetables at their homes for **improved nutrition**.




